Pieter Gillard, M.D.

Pieter Gillard studied medicine at the University of Leuven (KUL) where he received his training as internist, endocrinologist and nephrologist. He works as adjunct head of clinic at the endocrinology department of the university hospitals in Leuven, where he takes care of >1500 patients with type 1 diabetes. He has a specific interest in innovative therapies (e.g. continuous glucose monitoring, hybrid-closed loops, adjunctive therapies, immunotherapies), post-transplant diabetes and pancreas/islet transplantation. Pieter Gillard is adjunct-professor at the Faculty of Medicine, Biomedical Sciences and Pharmaceutical Sciences at the KUL and guest professor, Department PATH, VUB . He is involved in several clinical studies in type 1 and type 2 diabetes and conducts research on continuous glucose monitoring, hybrid-closed loop, diabetes nephropathy, islet transplantation and immunotherapy in patients with type 1 diabetes. In these domains, he published >100 original articles, supervises young researchers and is a partner in various national and European research programs.
