Sunil Vasantrya Badve, MD

Associate Professor Badve is a Senior Staff Specialist in Nephrology at St George Hospital, Sydney; Conjoint Associate Professor of Medicine at UNSW Medicine; and Program Lead, Cardiometabolic Trials, Renal and Metabolic Division at the George Institute for Global Health. He obtained his nephrology training in Mumbai, India and Ottawa, Canada and has been practising as a consultant nephrologist in Australia since 2009. He was awarded PhD by the University of Queensland in 2016 for a thesis 'Therapeutic interventions to improve clinical outcomes in advanced chronic kidney disease'. His research focus is in randomised controlled trials, meta-analyses and epidemiology, particularly in progression of chronic kidney disease and cardiovascular disease, and associated mortality in chronic kidney disease. He is a recipient of five NHMRC project grants with >\$10M. He has published more than 85 original articles in peer-reviewed journals. He is the Nephrology Subject Editor for the Internal Medicine Journal and Associate Editor of Trials.
